WHO WE ARE?

Hosanna Church Ministries was started 25 years ago at the Sundas residence, at Nayapati, Sundarijal. The key objective is to fulfill the Great Commission commanded by Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18-20). Established in 1994-95, Hosanna Church has embraced the Great Commission as its foundation, and "to know Jesus, make Him known, and make His people disciples" became its guiding principle. The inspiration for starting the church and the ministry is the Lord Jesus Himself.

HCM Nepal is a nongovernmental, non-profit organization. We are registered with the Kathmandu District Administrative Office and affiliated with the Social Welfare Council, Government of Nepal.

Achievements of HCM: Post-Pandemic

Firstly, we give all glory to God for the amazing achievement of the ministry. For 25 years HCM had followed the traditional ministry model to reach people. During the Covid-19 pandemic, many prominent pastors and leaders died and consequently, churches were closed. At the time, Pastor Raju Sundas was desperately seeking God and asking Him for ways to bring the gospel to the people, ways that cannot be disrupted by pandemic or other catastrophes. He was challenged by a faithful partner Mr. Ryan Skoog to read the Training for Trainers (T4T) book and to translate it to Nepali. The pandemic finally paved the

way for HCM to embrace the new approach which is that of house church planting.

To start, a pilot project was established to monitor the new approach and after seeing how impactful it was, we fully adopted this model. We have been using this model as our ministry platform for the last two years and God has been faithful to bring exponential change in our church.

Nepal has 125 people groups, of which 92 are unreached and unengaged meaning the people in these groups have not heard the Gospel, have not heard of Jesus.

Story of Ashish Mahato

Mr. Ashish Mahoto was in the discipleship group of Pastor Raju Sundas at HCM for about two years. During those two years, he was used by God to share Christ with thousands of unreached people groups. He has helped to plant 35 house churches in the southern part of Nepal. He also practiced generosity in such a way that he gave 30 percent of his income for local missions. Now he is in Korea working and sharing Christ.

Even though he is in Korea, he organizes weekly DMM trainings with people from 16 countries via zoom. No one can stop his passion to share Christ to the unreached.

How We work - our strategy

Engage - Prayer

Jesus, The Savior clearly taught us to pray for the harvest and for needed workers: "And he said to them, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest'" (Luke 10:2).

Evangelize - Intentional Evangelism

While acknowledging all of that, intentional evangelisation remains essential in the overall and continuing missionary task of the Church at every level. Such an intention is both at the centre of mission and its foundation. Without it, the mission would be like a house built on sand apt to be imperilled with every wind of change.

Equip - Training and vision casting

to equip fourth generations of discipeship we believe in the power of multiplication which is discipleship gratifying the heart of Jesus and augmenting the agenda of kingdom of God into the next generation. The only plan of action of our ministry is discipleship and multiplication.

Empower - to create House church planting multiplication movement

If you want to plant a church that is marked by **Love**, is able to **Attract** non-Christians, provides an excellent context for **Service**, Equips its members and can Reproduce itself into other **healthy churches**, perhaps the house church model is the model for you.

WHERE WE WORK

We are focusing on working among the unreached & unengaged people groups (UUPG) of Nepal, especially among the 92 UUPG where the need for the Gospel is at the greatest.

Nepal has 7 provinces and 77 districts. We have established work stations in all 7 provinces.

We would like to draw your attention to province 2 to highlight the urgency of reaching the people with the Gospel message.

Reaching the unreached - Bhojpuri People Group

The Bhojpuri people or Bhojpuriyas are a group from the Indian subcontinent who speak the Bhojpuri language and inhabit the Bhojpuri-Purvanchal region. This area is now divided between the western part of the Indian state of Bihar, the eastern part of the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh, along with some neighboring districts in the Madhesh (South) of Nepal like Rautahat, Bara, Parsa, Chitwan, Nawalparasi and Rupandehi.

Population of Bhojpuri in India and Nepal - 2.5 million

Pastor Ram Naryan Harijan is married with five children and still caring for his 110 years old father who is also active in church. Pastor Ram is called by God to work among the Bhojpuri people groups. This is one of the least reached people groups among the 92 UUPG. He has been in ministry for 22 years. He is based in Pratapur VDC in Nawalparasi, West Nepal.

He and his team have shared the Gospel with 100,000 people among the Bhojpuri people groups. And have led 6000 people to the Lord and planted 28 churches in Uttar Pradesh, India, 13 churches in Bihar India and 7 churches in Nepal.

He is envisioning with us to plant 1000 house churches in 2 years. Nothing - including being persecuted many times for the Gospel and being arrested six times by the police for his work - could stop him from preaching the Gospel to his people,. We are so grateful to God for giving him to our team.

Pastor Ram Naryan looks after 5 master church planter trainers (MCPT) in this region. As Pastor Naryan says, "The house church has changed the lives of many believers as they learn and grow in the Word and are given the opportunity to serve. Some things that we do in the house church includes praying for our community and sharing the Gospel to our people together. This has empowered us to grow deeper in Christ.

Power Evangelism - Tharu community West Nepal

The Tharu community live mostly in the area towards the southern parts of Nepal and Northern India. According to the census of 2011, the population of the Tharu group is 1,737,470. They are the most populous group among the indigenous tribes of Nepal. We have two MCPT pastors serving amongst the Tharu people group. Both Pastor Phul Ram Tharu and Pastor Bikash Nepali have seen amazing breakthroughs in the Tharu community. Through them 6000 people have heard the Gospel.

Pastor Bikash Nepali

is the Strategic Coordinator of Province 5 based in Bardiya District. He has shared Christ with 4000 people, out of which 1600 have accepted Christ and 1000 have been baptized this year alone.

He has planted 35 house churches, with a total of 435 people trained. He has seen 387 people healed by the miraculous power of God.

Mr Ganga B.K. was living in Koholpur when he had to go to Lucknow, India immediately because his left lung had stopped working. Because of his condition, he had to be hospitalized and cared for in a Lucknow hospital for two years. Though he lost most of his money and properties paying the hospital bills, he did not get better. When he finally returned home, he visited a church where he met Pastor Bikash. Pastor Bikash prayed over him with authority and miraculously his pain was gone and he was healed.

Mr. Kulhari called on Pastor
Bikash to pray for him when both
his kidneys stopped working. His
own people had lost hope for him.
He was not able to walk due to his
kidney failure and this led him to
also suffer from mental problem.
Pastor Bikash prayed over him
and miraculously his kidneys
started to function properly. He
gave his life to God and his people
who had lost hope gave their
lives to God as well. Due to the
powerful healing, it paved the way
for the Gospel to be preached.



Pastor Phul Ram Tharu

He is one of our Master church planters working among the Tharu people group. He serves at Bardiya Takia Village. This year alone, he has shared the Gospel with 1467 people, out of which 656 people accepted Christ and 250 people were baptized. He has trained 287 people with the DMM training model and planted 27 house churches. He is leading second-generation house church planters and overseeing third generation discipleship makers and supervising 4 other MCPT under his leadership.



Badi Community - House Church Planting Multiplication

The Badi community is classified under "the impure and untouchable" category by the Government of Nepal. The Badi people moved to Western Nepal from India in the 1700s travelling in groups and working as entertainers and staging musical performances from Hindu epics.

Population of Badi community in Nepal –76,000. Sex trade business first started in Sati located in Tikapur district, province 5. We have been praying for 17 years to start a church among the Badi community.

Shyam Rimakoti

Pastor Shyam has been working among the Badi community for some time now. When he was watching one of our online sermon videos on Youtube about the house church multiplication model, he was blessed and wanted to partner with and learn from us. When we met him at Kailali, we saw his burden to share Christ to the Badi community. We started a partnership with him to serve

among the Badi community in West Nepal. His vision was to start 100 house churches in every Badi village. Since taking the house church multiplication training at HCM central, he has started house churches in 16 Badi villages within just 3 months.

"I am really happy to serve the Badi community because they are the most backward community in Nepal. For many years they have become only takers, taking anything given to them but the most important thing they should take in is the love of Jesus, which is where I come in."

Global Prayer Stations

We have a Global Prayer Station where we pray for the 92 unreached people groups. We started this to dedicate these people groups to the Lord and seek guidance in reaching these groups. Our goal for the next year is to build 7 more prayer stations in 7 provinces of Nepal so everyone has the opportunity all over Nepal to pray for these 92 people groups.

Recording Studio

We built a recording studio at

the HCM central office to record teaching materials to share on social media platforms. Our desire is to widen our reach outside of Nepal as well. There are 17 million Nepali speaking people around the world of which only a small fraction are Christians. We want to reach them with the Good News of Christ, to share and implement the house church multiplication model used in Nepal with a vision of seeing Christ preached and taught and disciples made among Nepalis all over the world.

School of Great Commission

The School of Great Commission is our training facility where we train pastors and leaders on the why and how of Gospel sharing and house church multiplication. We have to date conducted 2 master church planters training where 100 church planters were trained and equipped.

Resource library

A separate room has been dedicated to house resources like T4T books, bibles, notebooks, calendars and Christian books on various Gospel themes and prayer. These resources are open to anyone interested to grow in their faith or who wants to know more about our movement. These resources are references available anytime within the room and building perimeter.

Provide Motorbikes

We were able to provide 8 motorbikes to 8 master church planters which enabled them to travel to tough places and train people for the end time harvest among the UUPG people groups.

The Station of Generostiy: Giving out of Love

We believe in local people involving in the mission by giving. Our partner Mr. Ryan Skoog challenged us and sent us to attend the Stations of Generosity training. Seven of us went to receive training in India and Nepal. Since then we have inserted this principle to our house church planting multiplication movement as well. We praise God for how local people are slowly getting involved by giving their resources to the movement.

During vision casting at Bardiya, West Nepal, among 1000 unreached people groups, we practiced generosity. The event had a deficit of 400,000 Nepali rupees but we challenged them to collect that amount locally. Amazingly one pastor donated 125 kilos of pig, one member donated 70 kilos of goat meat, three people gave their last gold rings and 275 kilos of rice and even children aged 5 to 6 were giving for the mission.

We were able to collect 423,000 which is USD 3500, more than we needed. We are now more thrilled to mobilize the practice of Generosity because we have a God who is the greatest giver of all.


